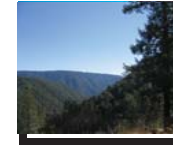
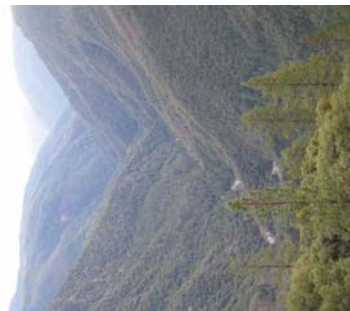

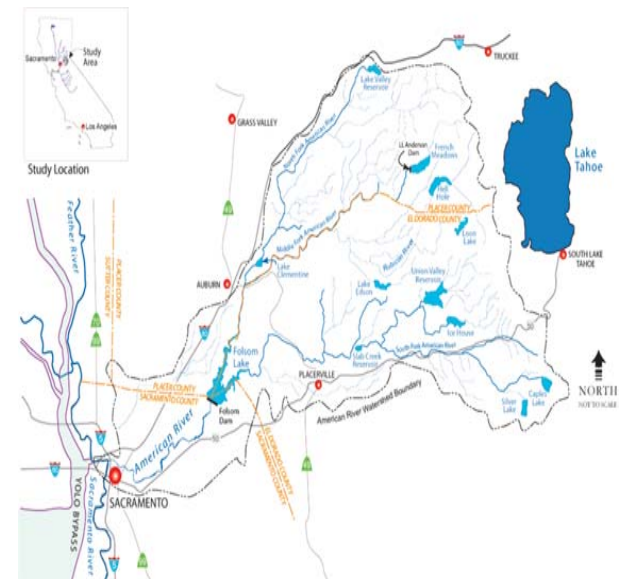

What Are Our Mission and Objectives?

The Upper American River Foundation is seeking nonprofit, status as a member-based organization founded in the spirit of the successful angler-based “Voice of the River” Henry’s Fork Foundation (<http://henrysfork.org> on the Snake River in Idaho) to conserve and protect the unique qualities of the upper American River watersheds located in Placer and El Dorado Counties in the Sierra Nevada of Central/Eastern California.



Our objectives include identifying issues that need to be resolved and developing the funding needed to help resolve them so future generations will continue to be able to enjoy the experiences that we have enjoyed during our lifetimes in this area.

Our approach includes working with existing resource-management

agencies and other stakeholders to increase the level of appreciation for and understanding of the abundant resources in this area.

We want to be very active in regional decision-making and policy. Relationships built within the framework of the foundation, will strive for full understanding of individual interests and regulatory management in the watersheds and to address watershed issues with mutual respect for all stakeholders.
